

NAME TAG WORKSHOP

Wed., Feb. 1, 2012, 6 pm

Have some fun making a Quilters' Guild name tag. The chickadee design can be applied using fabrics of your choice or embroidered using an outline stitch.

Don't forget to add the name of our guild at the top and your name at the bottom. These can be written either by using a fine-point, permanent fabric pen (i.e. Pigma pen) or you may use embroidery floss and embroider them.

Quilt as desired and add binding of your choice (perhaps matching one of the colors in the chickadee).



SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS:

- *Pigma pen or other fine point, permanent fabric marking pen for words (pre-test on fabric first) - you will also need a pencil for tracing the design on the muslin*
- *Off-white quilting thread (plus optional—green to quilt tassel and brown to quilt pine cone), scissors, other regular sewing supplies, including quilting needle*
- *Small piece of "Steam-a-Seam" or other paper-backed, fusible webbing*
- *Muslin for front of tag as well as a piece for backing*
- *Small piece of low-loft or traditional quilt batting*
- *Assorted scraps of small-print fabrics for chickadee*
- *1¼" to 1½" x 20" strip of small print fabric for binding, thread to match binding*
- *Iron and pad (every 4th or 5th person)*
