## **Quick Donation Quilt**

50" x 71"

At our April '09 business meeting, members were asked to donate quilts to the Sunrise County Dialysis Center in Eastport. Since one of our members is a patient there, we thought it would be a great place to donate quilts. There is a signup sheet available for those who would like to participate; thank you to those who have already done so. If anyone else would like to donate a quilt, please let Jen Lacasse (454-0903) know so she can add your name to the list.

We need 17 quilts so each patient can have one. The only requests are:

- Quilts should be approximately 45" x 70"
- Do not use white fabrics
- Use 100% cotton or flannel fabric
- Quilts should not be too bulky—please use a thin batting
- Use any pattern you like or the quick pattern below that was designed by Jen Lacasse

These quilts will be used as lap quilts for patients undergoing dialysis treatments to keep the chill out.

If you have one finished by our May business meeting, please give it to Leona Juranty. She has graciously offered to store the quilts until we have all 17. Once we have all of them, it would be a great idea to have a group of members go to Eastport to present the quilts. This way we can take a picture for the local newspapers.

## **Material:** cotton or flannel

1 yard of a focus fabric – cut 5 strips 6 ½" by WOF 1 ¼" yd of tone-on-tone (blue) – cut 10 strips 4" by WOF ¾ yd of accent fabric (green) – cut 10 strips 2 ½" by WOF ½ yd fabric for binding

## **Directions:**

- 1. Your width of fabric (WOF) may vary from each fabric so once your strips are cut determine which WOF is the shortest and cut all the strips to that length. Assemble as shown in the picture above starting with your tone on tone fabric. The two side borders will be sewn on last.
- 2. Use thin cotton batting.
- 3. Quilt as desired and bind.
