

# One-Piece Quilt Wrap

This is a safe way to store quilts. It is simple and will take up less storage space.

## Project Supplies for Quilt Wrap

ABS drainpipe, swimming pool “noodle”, or foam pipe insulation

- 2” outside diameter
- 2” – 4” longer than the width of your quilt.
- The drain pipe is stiffer and quilts can be stored standing in the back of a closet.

Cotton Muslin, sheet, or any large piece of cotton –

- 12” longer than pipe length,
- 15” longer than your quilt

Cotton twill tape or shoelaces

- 24” long – 2 pieces
- 36” long – one or more – one every 15’-18’ of quilt width

Plastic for removable paper label or fusible fabric identification label

## Sewing Supplies

- Quilt you want to wrap
- Sewing machine, measuring tape, thread to match fabric
