

Warm Wishes

58" x 69" Lap Quilt (set blocks 9 across x 11 down)

*This is an easy pattern to show off any large print fabric.
It's quick and versatile; you could make one for every season and holiday.*

BLOCK YARDAGE & CUTTING (includes 1/4" seam allowances):

1 1/2 yard multi-print focus fabric

(If you want to fussy-cut motifs from the print, you'll need more fabric)

Cut (7-8*) strips 6" x about 42" (width of fabric); sub-cut into (50) 6" squares for blocks

1 yard print to match or blend in with the background of the multi-print focus fabric

Cut (7-8*) strips 3" x about 42" (width of fabric) for blocks

2/3 yard contrasting print #1 to make frame

Cut (7-8*) 2" x about 42" (width of fabric) strips (pictured in green)

2/3 yard contrasting print #2 to make frame

Cut (7-8*) 2" x about 42" (width of fabric) strips (pictured in brown)

** the width of your fabrics will determine how many squares you'll be able to cut from each strip—you may need the 8th strip if some of your fabrics are narrower than 42" after selvages are removed.*



YOU WILL ALSO NEED (your choice of fabric):

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|------------------|--------------------|--|
| Border #1 | 2/3 yard | cut (6) strips 2" x about 42" (width of fabric) |
| Border #2 | 1 yard | cut (7) strips 3 1/2" x about 42" (width of fabric) |
| Binding | 2/3 yard | cut (8) strips 2 1/2" x about 42" strips (width of fabric) |
| Backing | 3 3/4 yards | pieced horizontally |
