Forget-Me-Not Wallhanging

Designed by Patricia Knoechel (Eleanor Burns' sister) and taught by Joline Cook, Theresa Wright, Peggy Sawyer, and Bonnie Hunter, this wallhanging features a pieced background, appliquéd bias vine, leaves, 3-D flowers as well as machine quilting, a scalloped border and bias binding.



FABRICS:

1 yard	Light background
½ yard	Multi-color or large-scale print
¼ yard	Forget-Me-Nots Blue Fabric A
⅛ yard	Forget-Me-Nots Blue Fabric B
⅛ yard	Extra flowers (optional)
¼ yard	Medium green, small corner triangles, leaves
⅝ yard	Dark green, bias binding, bias strips for vine, leaves
1 ⅛ yards	Backing

ALSO:

- (2) 3 ½" x 14" pieces lightweight fusible interfacing
- (11) ½" yellow buttons (or one for each flower)
- Hera Marker
- 12 ½" x 12 ½" square-up ruler
- 6" x 24" ruler
- Rotary cutter and mat
- **Scallops, Vines, and Waves Template** from Quilt-in-a-Day
- Ballpoint bodkin, hemostat or small crochet hook for turning flowers and leaves
- Plastic template plastic
- Fine point permanent marker for making templates
- Thread for machine piecing and to match vines and flowers
- Hand sewing needle for appliqué
- Sewing machine, cord, foot pedal, machine manual, extension cord, ¼" presser foot
- Scissors, seam ripper, bobbins, other sewing supplies
- Iron and pad (every 4th or 5th person)
- Snippet bag
