Supply List

This technique is from *Layered Waves* by Karen Eckmeier, author of *Accidental Landscapes*.

We'll be making a 4-block sampler to learn this technique. You'll need:

- Assorted dark 2"-2 ½" strips (minimum of 2" long to maximum of 44" long)
- Assorted light 2"-2 ½" strips (minimum of 2" long to maximum of 44" long)
- A separate accent color for the center block (four 2" squares)---or the centers can be scrappy
- A small amount of Wonder Under or other fusible web of your choice.
- Basic sewing supplies including a pair of sharp scissors
- Thread to either match your fabrics or to contrast with them---your choice!
- Sewing machine, extension cord
- Iron and ironing surface
- Rotary cutter and mat
